YEAR B-First Sunday of Advent: The readings for this week at Mass is Mark 13:33-37. If Lent is the season of repentance, Advent is the season of promise. We hear over and over again God's promise of salvation for his people. The first Sunday of Advent traditionally focuses on our need to be vigilant and avoid being taken by surprise when Christ returns at the end of our earthly lives. Only God knows whenever that might be, and the emphasis today is on being ready!

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.
