YEAR B-Fifth Sunday of Lent: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of St. John (12:20-33).

In the lead-up to the Passion and death of Jesus, today's Gospel provides us with another image of Christ's death in the cross. We reflect on the image of a grain of wheat which falls to the ground and gives up its life in order to produce a rich harvest.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.
