**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi):** The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of St. Luke (9:11b-17).

Today is the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ or Corpus Christi. Corpus Christi means Body of Christ; we focus on the Eucharist in a special and dedicated way today.
