## St. Peter's Church Children's Liturgy

**17<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:** The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of St. Luke (11:1-13).

Jesus often set aside time to spend in the company of his heavenly Father by praying. There are many different ways to pray, but whatever method we choose to use, to feel that God is very close and listening to us fills us with comfort and very special sense of peace.

#### Our Father- The Lord's Prayer

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. Amen.
