St. Peter's Church Children's Liturgy

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of St. Luke (15:1-10).

A parable is a story with the meaning that is not explained but left for the listener to work out. Jesus used parables that related to everyday life at the time. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells two parables to help people understand the depth of God's love for us.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

Our Father- The Lord's Prayer

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. Amen.
