Pentecost: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of St. John (20:19-23).

Several days after Jesus had returned to heaven, the Jewish people celebrated the festival of Pentecost. Jesus' closest friends were hiding away together when they experienced a remarkable event that would change their lives and the lives of every Christian for ever. Today we celebrate that outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Christ's apostles, an event that marked the birthday of the Church.
