The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of St. Matthew (28:16-20). The faith of all Christians is rooted in the mystery of the Trinity. Much of this mystery is beyond our comprehension, our imagination, and our understanding. We must rely on the gift of faith to open our hearts and minds to help us to accept and believe in a God who is Father, a God who is Son, a God who is Spirit; but a God made one by love.
