WEEK OF: Feb 11-12, 2023

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of St. Matthew (5:17-24).

The gospel of St. Matthew 5:17-24 explains that Jesus came to fulfill the Law and not to abolish it. Jesus teaches that it is not enough to obey the law outwardly; true faithfulness requires that we keep the law in our hearts. Jesus warns against sin and encourages us to strive to be perfect as God is perfect. He also teaches us to be merciful and forgiving towards others, and to treat others as we would want to be treated. Through this, we can be true to the law and stay close to God.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.
