Third Sunday of Easter: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of Lk 24:13-35.

Summary: The Gospel reading tells the story of how two disciples met Jesus on the road to Emmaus but did not recognize Him until He broke bread with them.

Key theme: The resurrection of Jesus Christ and how He is present with us in the breaking of the bread.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.
