Fourth Sunday of Easter: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of Jn 10:1-10.

Summary: The Gospel reading tells the story of how Jesus compared Himself to a shepherd and His followers to sheep. He said that He is the gate for the sheep and whoever enters through Him will be saved.

Key theme: Jesus is the way to salvation and a good shepherd who protects His followers.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.
