Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time: The readings for this week at Mass is from the Gospel of Matthew 9:36-10:8.

Jesus sees the crowds and has compassion on them because they are like sheep without a shepherd. He commissions his disciples, giving them authority to heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, and cast out demons.

Jesus instructs them to go and proclaim the message of the kingdom of heaven, freely giving what they have received.

Theme: Compassion and the call to share the message of the kingdom of heaven.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. Amen.
