Theme: The central theme of the story of Adam and Eve's disobedience in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3:1-24) is disobedience and its consequences, specifically the consequences of not following God's instructions. It also touches upon the concepts of temptation, sin, and God's continued love and care for humanity despite their disobedience.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.
