Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Exodus 1:1-22 are the multiplication of the Israelites in Egypt, their descent into slavery under a new Pharaoh who feared their growth, and the foreshadowing of God's plan to help the Israelites.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but

3. How did the Egyptians treat the Israelite slaves, and why was it unfair?
4. Why do you think the new Pharaoh was afraid of the Israelites?
5. What do you think the phrase "God had a plan to help the Israelites" means, and why is it important in this story?
