God protects baby Moses. Exodus 2:1-10:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Exodus 2:1-10 are the threat to Israelite baby boys by Pharaoh, the protective actions of Moses' mother, the miraculous survival of baby Moses through the princess's intervention, and his upbringing in the Pharaoh's palace.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but

- 4. How did the princess react when she found the baby in the basket, and why did she feel sorry for him?
