#### God talks to Moses. Exodus 3:1-4:17:

**Theme:** The key themes of this gospel reading from Exodus 3:1—4:17 are Moses' encounter with God through the burning bush, God's call for Moses to lead the Israelites out of slavery, Moses' initial fear and reluctance, and God's assurance and provision for Moses through the assistance of his brother Aaron.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

Our Father,
who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
deliver us from evil.

- 1. What was Moses doing in the desert when he saw the burning bush?

- 3. What did God want Moses to do for the Israelites, and why?
- 4. Why was Moses afraid, and how did God reassure him?
- 5. How did God plan to help Moses convince Pharaoh, and who did God say would assist Moses in this task?
