God makes a path through the Red Sea. Exodus 14:1-31:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Exodus 14:1-31 are the Israelites' escape from the pursuing Egyptian army, God's miraculous intervention in parting the Red Sea to create a path for the Israelites, and the demonstration of trust in God's deliverance.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but

- 3. How did God help the Israelites cross the Red Sea, and what did the people experience as they walked through?
- 4. What happened to the Egyptian army when they tried to follow the Israelites through the Red Sea?
