God gives the Ten Commandments. Exodus 19:1-24:18:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Exodus 19:1—24:18 are the Israelites' arrival at Mount Sinai, God's communication with Moses on the mountain, the giving of the Ten Commandments as God's laws for the people to follow, and the people's commitment to obeying God.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
deliver us from evil.
Amen.

- 1. Why did the Israelites camp by the mountain in the desert?
- 2. What did God tell Moses to do, and what did God give him on the mountain?
- 3. What were the stone tablets that God gave to Moses, and what was written on them?
- 4. Why did God give the Israelites laws, and what were some of these laws?
- 5. How did the people respond to what Moses told them about God's laws, and why is it important to obey God's commandments?
