God provides water from a rock. Numbers 20:1-13:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading involve the people's complaint about a lack of water in the desert, Moses' frustration, his disobedience to God's instructions, and God's provision of water despite Moses' actions, along with the importance of obedience to God.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but

5. What can we learn from this story about trusting God even when we are frustrated or facing challenges?
