Rahab helps two spies. Joshua 2:1-24:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Joshua 2:1-24 include Joshua's leadership, God's promise to be with Joshua, the sending of spies to Jericho, Rahab's bravery in hiding the spies, and the promise of safety for Rahab and her family.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
