Ruth shows love. Ruth 1:1-22:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Ruth 1:1-22 are loyalty, love, and devotion, as seen in Ruth's commitment to her mother-in-law Naomi despite difficult circumstances and her willingness to embrace Naomi's culture and faith.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

as we forgive those who trespass against
