Samuel chooses a king. 1 Samuel 8:1–10:24

Theme: The key themes of this Bible story from 1 Samuel 8:1–10:24 include the Israelites' desire for a human king instead of God as their ruler, Samuel's warning about the consequences of having a king, God's selection of Saul as the first king of Israel, and Saul's preparation for kingship with God's help.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

Our Father,
who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
deliver us from evil.
Amen.
