Theme: The key themes of this Bible story from 1 Kings 17:1-6 include obedience to God, divine provision, and God's care for His faithful servant Elijah, as He sends ravens to bring food to him during a time of drought and famine.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
deliver us from evil.
Amen.

Gospel Reflection Activity Sheet:

- Who was the king of Israel during this time, and what did he do that made God angry?
- 2. What did Elijah tell King Ahab about the rain and the consequences?
- 3. Why did God instruct Elijah to hide from the king, and where did Elijah go?
- 4. How did God provide food for Elijah while he was hiding by the brook?
- 5. What can we learn from this story about trusting God to provide for us even in difficult circumstances?
