Josiah hears God's Word. 2 Kings 22:1-23:3; 2 Chronicles 34:14-32:

Theme: The key themes of this Bible story from 2 Kings 22:1–23:3; 2 Chronicles 34:14-32 include the discovery and importance of God's Word, the response of repentance and obedience to God's Word, and the impact of a young king's leadership in bringing about spiritual renewal.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

Our Father,
who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
deliver us from evil.
Amen.
