Abraham's servant finds a wife for Isaac. Genesis 24:1-67:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Genesis 24:1-67 are the search for a suitable wife for Isaac, the role of divine guidance in the selection of Rebekah as Isaac's wife, and the importance of kindness and generosity in their meeting.
