The walls of Jericho fall down. Joshua 6:1-27:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from Joshua 6:1-27 include the strategic plan given by God to Joshua to conquer Jericho, the obedience of the Israelites in following God's instructions, the miraculous falling of the city walls, and the successful entry of the Israelites into Jericho.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

Our Father,
who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
deliver us from evil.
Amen.

- What happened on the last day of marching around Jericho, and why did the walls fall down?
- What can we learn from this story about trusting and obeying God even when the plan seems unusual or challenging?
