Elijah goes to heaven. 2 Kings 2:1-14:

Theme: The key themes of this gospel reading from 2 Kings 2:1-14 include the passing of the prophetic mantle from Elijah to Elisha, the miraculous departure of Elijah to heaven, the continuity of God's work through His servants, and the assurance of God's presence and help.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on
earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our
daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against
us. And lead us not into temptation; but
deliver us from evil.

3. How did Elijah leave this world, and what did Elisha see when Elijah was taken up?
4. What did Elisha do after Elijah was gone, and why was it important?
5. How do you think Elisha felt knowing that God was with him and would help him in his new role?
