Theme: The key themes of this Bible story from 1 Samuel 17:1-58 include courage, faith in God's strength, and the triumph of the underdog as David, a young shepherd, defeats the giant Goliath with God's help.

Please begin your learning with the prayer in the 'Heart' section, then with the work in the 'Head' section, followed by applying your knowledge in the 'Hands' section.

as we forgive those who trespass against

- 4. How did King Saul react to David's willingness to fight Goliath, and what did David tell him?
